Dear Parent/Guardian,

Salem Christian Academy has received your request for self-administration of _____, an asthma medication, for your child

State law requires that we inform the parents or guardians of the student, in writing, that the Salem Baptist Church of Chicago nor Salem Christian Academy and its employees and agents are to incur no liability, except for willful and wanton conduct, as a result of any injury arising from the self-administration of medication by the student.

Before we can allow your child _____ to self-administer the medication, we must ask that you sign and return a copy of this document.

The permission for self-administration of medication is effective for the school year for which it is granted and shall be renewed each subsequent school year upon fulfillment of the requirements outlined above. A student with asthma may possess and use his/her medication while in school, at a school-sponsored activity, while under the supervision of school personnel, or before or after normal school activities, such as while in Before-school or Afterschool care on school-operated property. We recommend that you provide an additional dose of the medication to be kept at school in the event that your child forgets or loses his/her medication.
